

Camp Dates: Session 1: June 15–18

Cost: \$185 (Child of BW employee is \$160).
If sending two boys from the same household, the cost for the second boy is \$160 (\$135 for second child of a BW employee)
\$135 for any additional boy in the same household (\$110 for any additional child of BW employee)

Camp Features: Camp T-Shirt, Instruction by BW Basketball Staff and Players, Teaching of Basketball Fundamentals, Team Competition, Foul Shooting Contest, Hot Shot Contest, 1 on 1 Contest, 3 on 3 Contest, and an awards ceremony at the conclusion of camp on Thursday. Camp starts at 9:00 am each morning and finishes at 3:00 p.m.

Camp Philosophy

Our main goal is to teach and develop the skills and concepts in the game of basketball. The camp will stress basketball fundamentals and is designed to give full attention to each camper, assuring that each camper receives the individual attention necessary to become a better player. The Baldwin Wallace Men's Basketball Camp provides each camper with opportunities to grow as a player and to have fun with others who want to learn more about basketball. We will provide quality instruction and a positive fun-filled experience for all campers!

Camp Staff

The camp staff will consist of the members of the Baldwin Wallace Men's Basketball Coaching staff, current and former Baldwin Wallace Men's Basketball Players, area high school coaches, and other college coaches. The camp staff will work hard to ensure that everyone attending camp gets quality instruction on the fundamentals of basketball along with a positive and fun experience.

Concessions/Camp Bank

Campers will be able to deposit money into a camp bank account which can be used for concessions (water, Gatorade and snacks) during break times and for pizza at lunch. Campers are welcome to bring their own lunch. All unused money will be refunded at the end of camp on Thursday.

From East via I-90: I-90 west to I-271 south. Take exit 27 to 480 west to I-71 south. Exit I-71 south at Bagley Rd. Right onto E. Bagley Rd. Left onto Beech Street. Immediate left into the Lou Higgins Center parking lot

From East (via I-80 or I-76): I-80 or I-76 west to I-80 (Ohio Turnpike) west. Exit I-80 at I-71, US 42. Take I-71 north approximately 2 miles to the Bagley Rd. exit. Left onto E. Bagley Rd. Left onto Beech Street. Immediate left into the Lou Higgins Center parking lot

From West (via I-80): Take I-80 (Ohio Turnpike) to I-71 north at Strongsville. Take I-71 north approximately 2 miles to the Bagley Rd. exit. Left onto E. Bagley Rd. Left onto Beech Street. Immediate left into the Lou Higgins Center parking lot

From South (via I-77, or I-71): I-77 north to Rt. 18 Medina. Take Rt. 18 west to I-71 north. Exit I-71 north at Bagley Rd. Left onto E. Bagley Rd. Left onto Beech Street Immediate left into the Lou Higgins Center parking lot

Tom Heil, Head Coach

In five seasons as a college head coach, Heil has five straight winning seasons, a current 91-48 career record with a .654 winning percentage, three conference championship game appearances with one league title, two tournament titles and a pair of

berths in the NCAA Division III National Tournament.

This season, Heil's team, led by seniors Jay Battle and Kyle Nader, took a 20-8 record into the "Big Dance". The team won three straight road games in the 2019 OAC Tournament and in its last two victories, knocked off two of the three OAC tri-champs during the regular season. Seniors Battle and Nader each earned All-OAC honors and four others earned Academic All-OAC accolades.

As BW head coach, Heil has a 69-41 career record with a .627 winning percentage.

Prior to returning to BW, he served as the head coach at Defiance College for one season, leading the Yellow jackets to a 22-7 record, including a 15-0 mark at home. Defiance captured both the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference regular season and HCAC Tournament titles. Heil guided his team into the NCAA Division III National Tournament where it posted the school's first-ever NCAA Division III National Tournament victory by knocking off the defending national champions, Wisconsin Whitewater.

Heil previously served for five seasons on the BW coaching staff as assistant to Duane Sheldon '94, helping to guide the team to a 58-44 overall and 49-33 OAC mark.

He also served as an assistant coach at Defiance (2007-2009). Those two seasons, DC posted marks of 19 and 18 wins, respectively, and captured the 2007-2008 HCAC regular season championship.

Heil played four seasons of varsity basketball at Bluffton University where he was twice named to the Academic All-HCAC team. He also captained the 2006-2007 squad that finished with a school-record tying 18 wins.

Heil earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in business administration at Bluffton in 2007.
